

QUESNEL OUTDOOR CUTTING HORSE SHOW JULY 17, 18, 19 SHOW INFO

*****this show has NCHA approval, but will not receive**

Northern Health approval until early JULY***

- There will be no concession, so bring your own food and beverages.
- The grounds and the show are not open to the general public. All people entering the grounds are part of a family unit or a barn unit and are showing, loping, or caring for horses.
- All **entry fees** must be paid no later than NOON Saturday July 18.
- Stalls bookings will be open on June 18. Call 250-249-5278
- Stall priorities is for show horses, first and then turnback horses. If space is available, then three year olds can also get stalls.
- Shavings are available – bed your own stalls. No clean out required. \$100 for the show
- Entries will be open on the BCCHA website beginning June 18. Entries CLOSE July 10.
- Alex Fraser Park will open for arrivals at 4 PM on Thursday July 16.
- A gate attendant will check you in and record names/families/barn groups, assign power hook-up and review parking protocol. Also need to complete a brief COVID-19 questionnaire/waiver upon arrival. You will also receive a Cutting Show Pass
- Green space camping WITH hydro is \$40 per night – trailer units must be 25 feet apart
- Green space camping WITHOUT hydro is \$15 per night – trailers must be 30 feet apart
- Trailers cannot be parked in the barn area. Unloading/loading is permitted
- Used cattle practice will be after the show on Friday and Saturday on a sign up basis each day
- There will be a flag in the warm-up area - \$20 for 5 minutes
- Monogramed Quesnel Cutting vests will be awarded in all classes to the aggregate winner
- There may be used cattle in the 2000LR, 35 NP, and 15AM for a reduced charge
- NCHA Rule 35 will be in effect over the entire Alex Fraser Park sight.
- 4yr old OPEN and 4yr old NP will be on July 17 and 18 – 2 goes only, three head of cattle in Open and NP
- ORDER OF GO: Open, 50 AM, 25 NH, 35 NP, 750 Progressive Rider and Nervous Novice, 25 NHNP, NP Break 4yr Open, 4yr NP, 5 NH, 2000LR, 5NHNP, 15 AM, 750 Progressive Rider
Note: Classes may be combined to make better herd sizes.
