

COVID-19 Protocols Quesnel Indoor Cutting Horse Show

1. If you are sick, please stay home
2. If you have traveled outside of Canada and haven't been in self isolation for 14 days before the show, please stay home
3. If you get sick after entries close you can withdraw without penalty or cattle charges
4. Social Distancing - 6 feet apart (one horse length) is to be maintained at all times
5. No spectators allowed in the arena, barn area or trailer parking area – this show is closed to the public
6. Sanitizing Stations, hand sanitizer, and wipes will be located around the park. Please bring your own hand sanitizer and masks as well.
7. Indoor bathrooms are available and will be sanitized frequently during the day.
8. Please limit your time in the stall area to feeding and cleaning only
9. No trailers can be parked at any time in the barn areas unless unloading
10. Masks & gloves are optional and can be worn while showing, if you choose
11. All competitors and vehicles MUST check in at the entrance gate. You will receive parking information, show information, and COVID19 protocol information, as well as a vehicle pass. Contestants will be checked off the entry list as they enter the park and receive a contestant wrist band.
12. Trailers in camping in the green space with hydro hook-up will be 25 feet apart. Park at the designated numbered spot you are assigned.
13. All other trailers, either parked or camping without hydro, must be 30 feet apart in the green space.
14. Contestants will warm-up in the outside arena and only enter the competition arena when their class begins.
15. When you are finished showing and NOT camping on the grounds, please leave and avoid increasing the number of people in the area.
16. Staff working in close proximity in the announcing booth, video area and judge area will need to wear PPE masks.
17. The show secretary will have social distancing in effect in the show office area. ONE person at a time to the show counter.
18. The competition arena will have signs designating ENTRANCE and EXIT
19. MAX of 50 people in the competition arena.
20. The remote for the practice flag will be wiped after each use by the flag manager.

Please respect the protocols and help make this a safe and happy cutting contest. Anyone willfully disregarding protocols may be asked to leave the show and entry fees will not be refunded.
